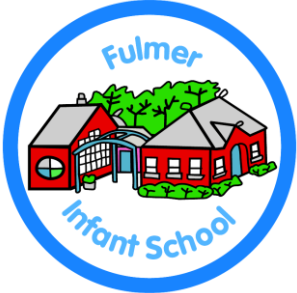

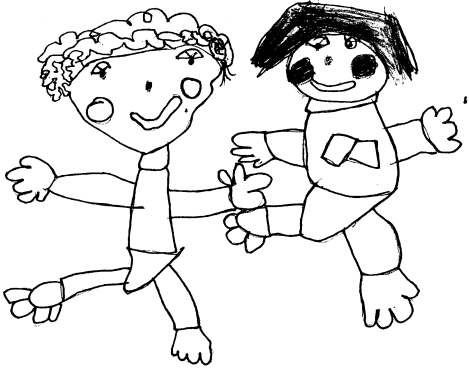


Pupils (Parents, please would you go through this with your child to make sure that he/she understands it.)

HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

- Ensure that we make arrangements for our child to leave school safely and punctually every day
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for learning, behaviour and discipline
- Support our child with homework and encourage a love of reading and books
- Inform the school about anything that is happening at home that might affect our child's well-being, learning and good behaviour
- Attend parent-teacher consultations about our child's progress
- Only take holidays within the school's holiday periods.
- Recognise that the school is part of Fulmer village and show respect for residents, particularly when parking cars at the beginning and end of the day.
