

FULMER INFANT SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

At Fulmer Infant School we expect all children to wear school uniform when attending school. We believe that this helps all children feel part of the school family and have a greater sense of belonging.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Our policy is based on the notion that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of belonging to, and pride in, the school
- Makes all children feel equal to their peers
- Is practical and smart
- Is good value and, as an ECO school, we encourage the purchase of pre-loved uniform
- Is easy to wear

UNIFORM

All uniform, water bottles and book bags must be clearly marked. Children may like to personalise their book bag by attaching a small key ring, teddy or ribbon. The colours of our school uniform are royal blue, grey and white.

The shop is open 7 days a week and there is in store shopping, in store pick-up and delivery. Most items of clothing, which do not have logos, may be purchased from local supermarkets or from our pre-loved stock, sold by our Friends of Fulmer, to raise funds for the school.

UNIFORM

V -neck jumper/cardigan (Sportcrest)

White polo shirt (with logo, Sportcrest)

Grey trousers, skirt, or pinafore dress

Grey or black socks

Sensible, sturdy shoes (preferably with Velcro fastening if the child cannot do laces) and no flashing lights!

Blue/white checked school dress (summer weather)

Grey shorts (summer weather) Blue tights or white socks Book bag (Sportcrest)

<u> PE KIT</u>

Blue T-shirt (Sportcrest) Black trainers (with Velcro if possible) Navy blue school tracksuit (Sportcrest)

SUNNY WEATHER

During sunny weather all children will need a sun hat or legionnaires cap. For cold weather a woolly hat is required. Children go outside in most weathers so hooded coats are needed every day from September onwards.

JEWELLERY

For Health and Safety reasons jewellery is not permitted in school.

<u>HAIR</u>

Parents should tie back any hair, which is long enough, securely with a plain blue scrunchie/band.
