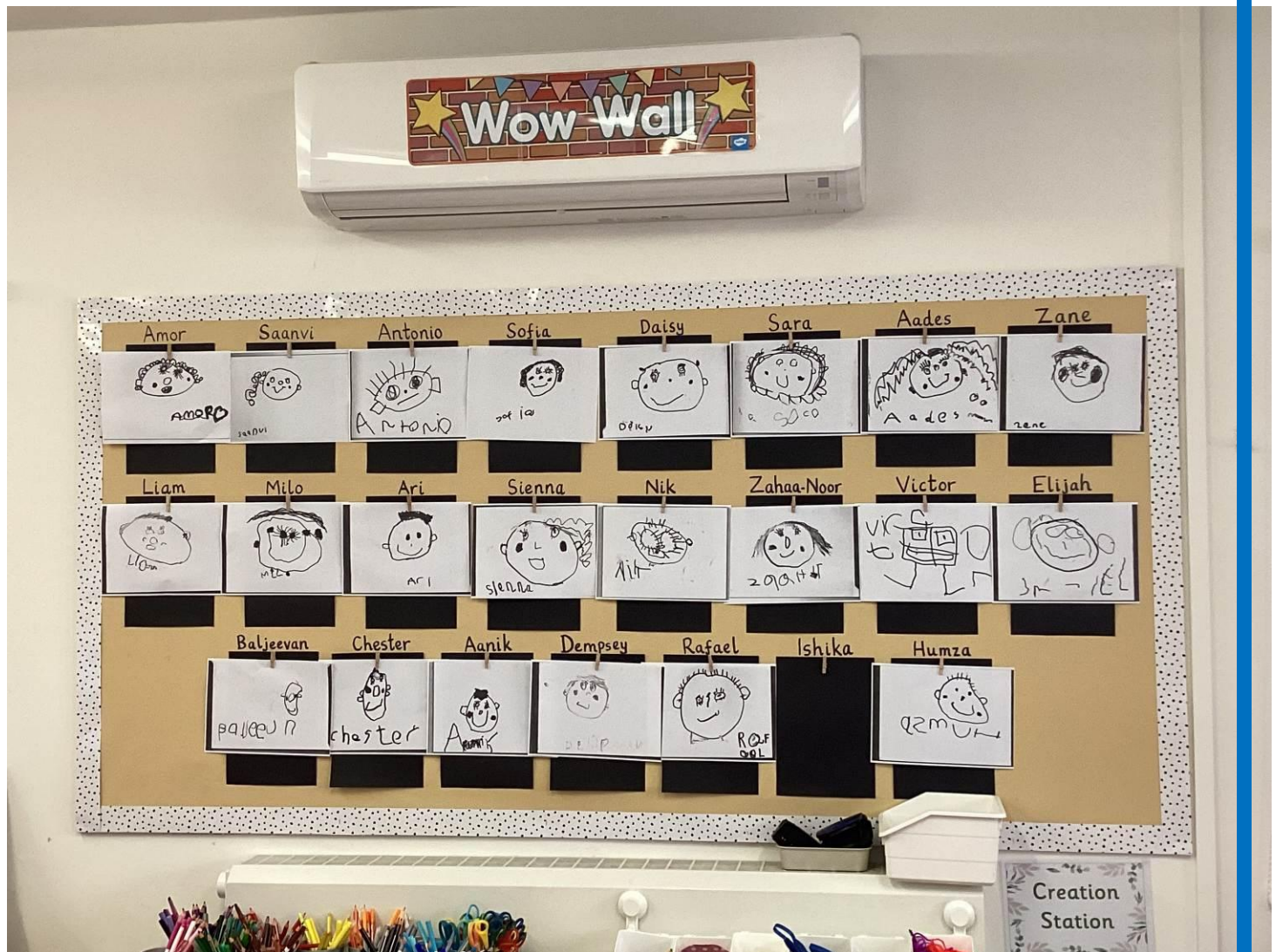




Dear Parents and Carers

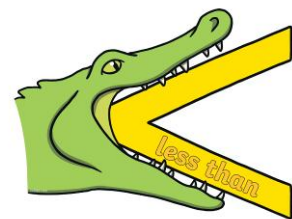
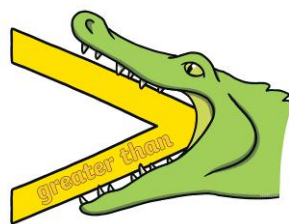


Reception have enjoyed drawing self-portraits. We discussed our facial features, where they are positioned and compared how they differ from one another.

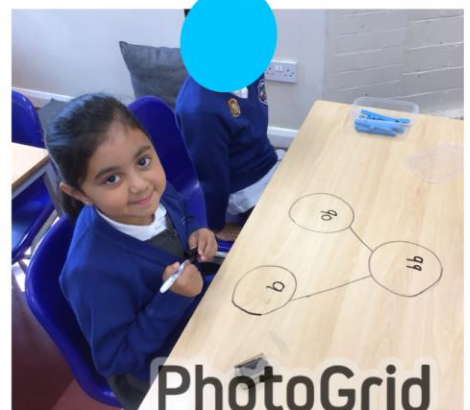
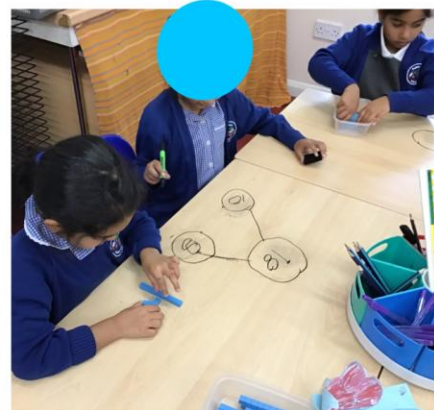
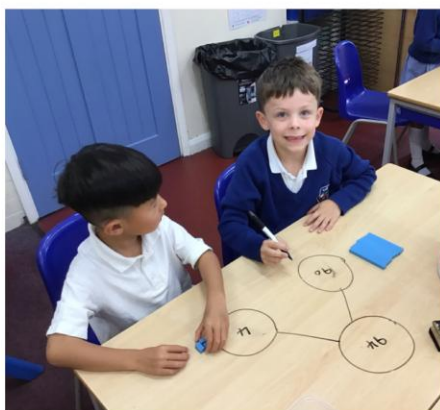
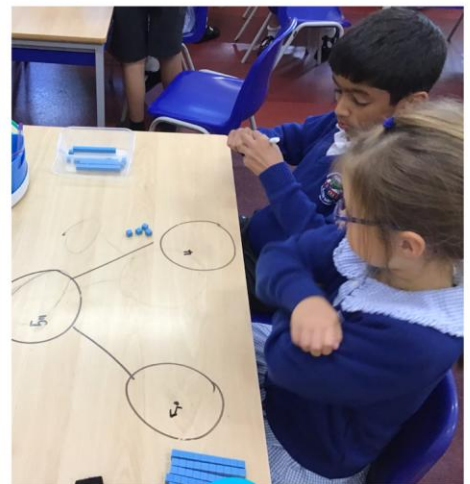
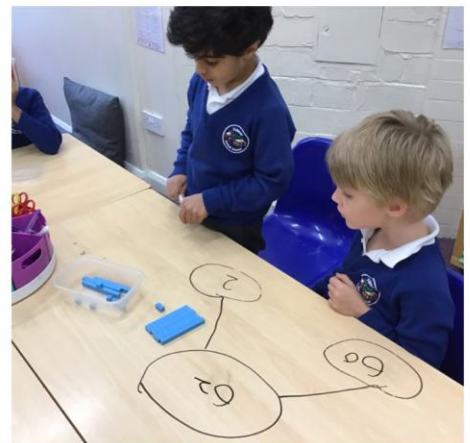
Year 1

Attendance at School

We all know how important it is for children to attend school regularly. To help with this, please avoid booking any holidays in term time because we need children learning in school every day. We have a school target of 96% and ask you to help us achieve it. 90% attendance may sound quite good, but it actually means your child is missing the equivalent of:

- One half day each week
- Nearly four weeks every school year
- Over one year in a school career

Best classes for attendance are:

Week ending 19.09.25: Reception at 100%

Week ending 26.09.25: Reception at 98%

If your child is absent from school, please advise the school office by telephone or email by 9:30am on each day they are absent. Thank you for your cooperation with this.

The importance of arriving at school on time

School starts at **8:55am**. The children come into school and begin their phonics lessons as soon as the register is taken. This means **the first lesson of the day starts at 9:00am**. If your child arrives late to school, they are missing the beginning of the first lesson of the day.

Please speak to Mrs Matton if you are experiencing any specific issues with arriving at school on time.



Parking and Respecting our Neighbours

The Black Horse Pub are kindly allowing parents to use the spaces in the front car park, **except for the first 10 bays**, when dropping off their children in the morning. No parking is available at the end of the school day.

Please refrain from parking on the yellow zig zag lines in front of the school. This keeps the school gate clear and is important for the safety of our children and families when arriving and leaving school.

Please also ensure you are parking considerately ensuring **all driveways are left clear and access to the road is not restricted**. Once again, this week, the school has received complaints from local residents where parents are parking over their driveways. Not only is this inconsiderate it can also mean that school staff are placed in very difficult situations. Your support in alleviating this will be appreciated by all concerned.

We have also been advised by Thames Valley Police that parking over a driveway is a violation of the Highway Code and parents are requested to bear this in mind when parking.

Thank you as always to our parents who continue to park considerately. Your support in making the journey to and from school safe for everyone is appreciated.
