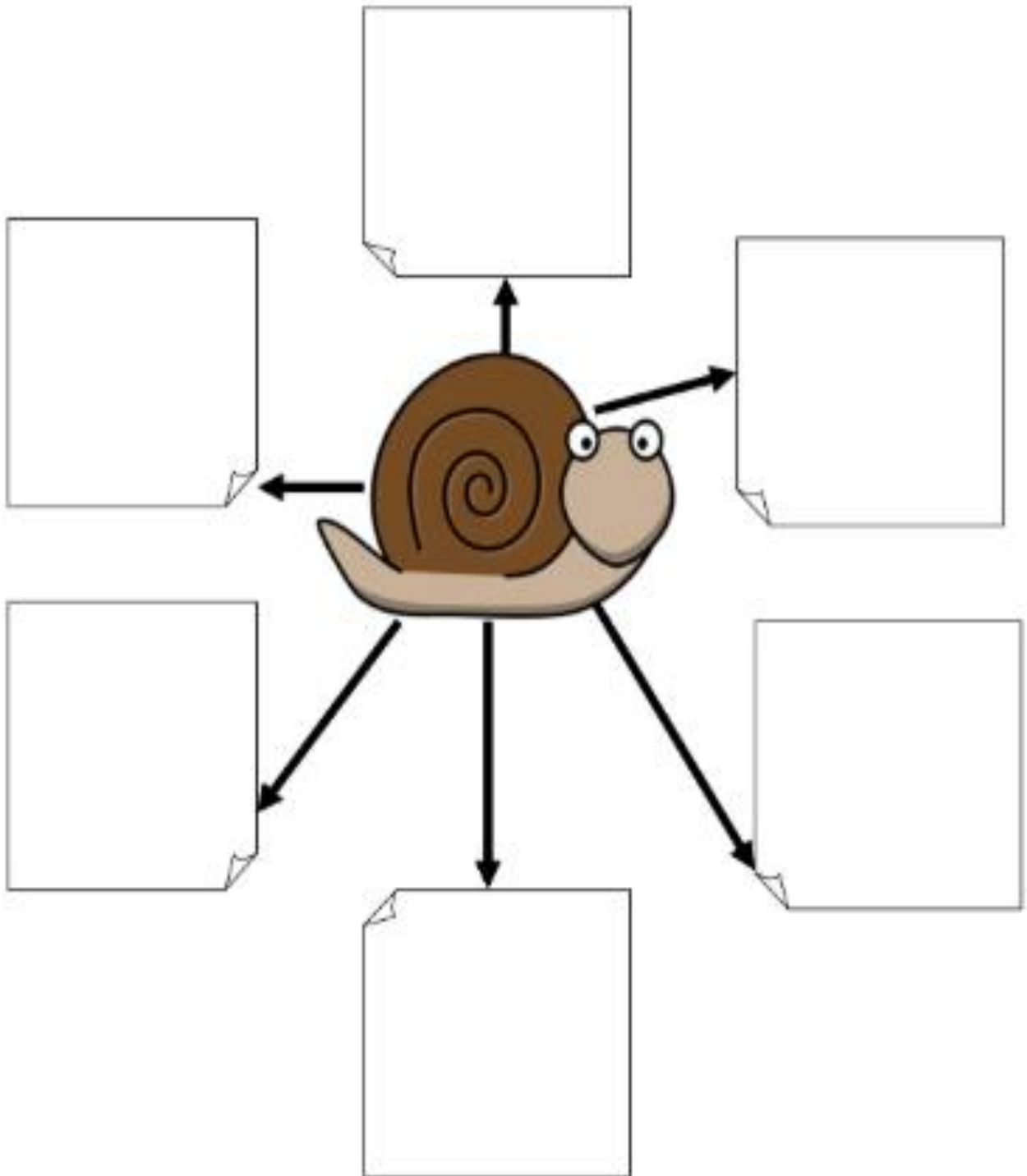
This is the whale who came one night

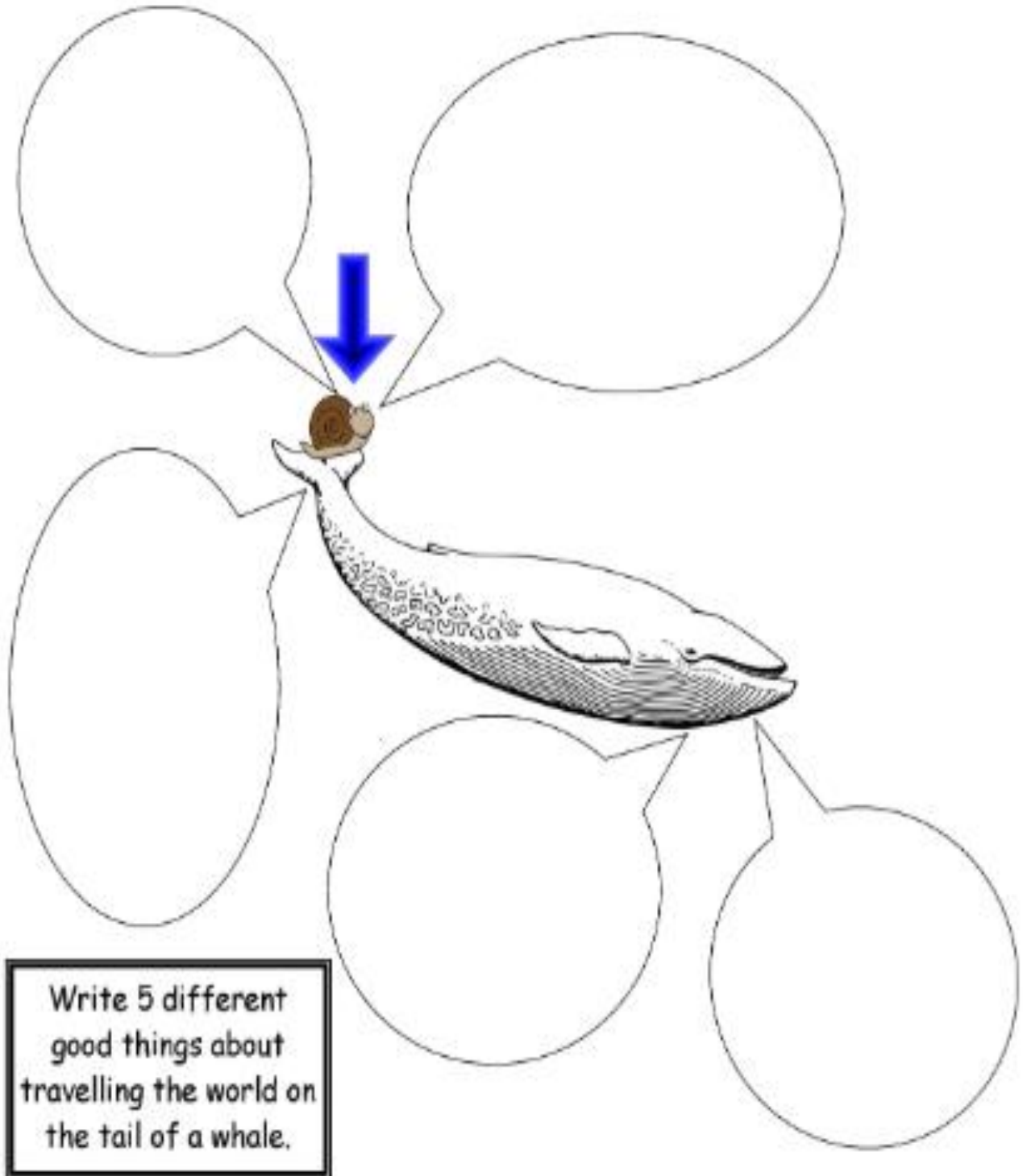
