

REMOTE LEARNING FULMER INFANT SCHOOL SPRING TERM 2021



At Fulmer Infant school we teach the same curriculum remotely as we do in school. This is a planned and well sequenced curriculum in a number of different subjects.

We provide 3 hours of education per day for Key Stage 1 children but less for Reception children. We do not suggest a daily timetable as every family has different demands but our expectation is for all children to complete the work in a week at their own pace. It may help if families set routines to support their child's learning. We understand however that there may be the occasional time when work cannot be completed as we accept that this is a stressful time for all and the well being of your child is of paramount importance.

We use the following digital platforms: Tapestry and ZOOM for Reception and a combination of ZOOM, Micosoft TEAMS and School Cloud for KS1.

We use a range of commercial and home made recordings including the Oaks Academy recordings which are endorsed by the Government.

We will endeavour to find laptops/tablets for families who require them.

We will print out work for those families who do not have access to a printer.

Feedback will be online on a daily basis, if a child does not engage for two occasions then the classteachers/ Co-Headteachers will follow this up with a phone call to offer support to the family.

- Resources and tasks: Work for the following week uploaded to Microsoft TEAMS every Sunday evening and monitored daily with feedback (up until 3:pm) on work submitted. Work is recorded in exercise books provided by the school
- Exchange of books: Every Monday from 11:30 – 13:00

YEAR 2

- Live overview of the week's work: Every Monday morning on Microsoft TEAMS
- Live registration: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday on Microsoft TEAMS
- Live storytime: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday with Mrs Mardell and every Tuesday with Mrs Hunt on Microsoft TEAMS
- Resources and tasks: Work for the following week uploaded every Sunday evening to Microsoft Teams and monitored daily with feedback on work submitted (up until 3pm) Work will be recorded in exercise books provided by the school
- Exchange of books and any extra resources: Every Monday from 13:30 - 14:30

CATCH UP PROGRAMME AND SEN SUPPORT

Mrs MacKinder teaches the children in small groups, following the targets in their support plans, on a Tuesday, whole day on ZOOM, and Friday, half a day in person for those eligible children in school.
